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**OFFICIAL RULES**

Thank you for participating in the talent show process.

1. It is required that all of the members of each act be enrolled at Cypress Creek Middle High School. Attendance at the show is open to all students, faculty/staff.
2. A maximum of 8 individuals are eligible to perform in each act unless an exception is given. Only those listed on the application are eligible to perform. Once the entry form is submitted, no name changes, additions/subtractions, or substitutions will be permitted without special permission. All individuals must be students at CCMHS. No changes will be permitted after audition deadline of **February 16, 2018**.
3. An individual may perform in up to two acts as long as they are in different performance categories.
4. Auditions will be held in the fine arts suite on **February 16, 2018**. Registration check-in for auditions will begin at **2:00 p.m.** **You will need to turn in your application. Once entries are submitted you will be assigned an audition time.** Auditions will begin at **2:15 p.m.** and end at approximately at **5:00 p.m.** You cannot audition without previously filling out an application and signing up for an audition time. A mandatory rehearsal will be held in the cafeteria on **March 12, 2018** from 2-4PM. The Talent Show will be on **March 14, 2018 for middle school and March 15, 2018 for high school, during school** in the Cafeteria. Only acts that have auditioned and been chosen by judges panel will be eligible to compete in the final show. We encourage you to practice on your own if you are chosen to compete in the final show. **Your audition piece must be complete and the final version in which you will perform.** Entries that change music, costuming, and/or movement will leave ground for disqualification. Sorry, but no parents will be able to attend the show as it is a school day performance. We will have the TV Productions team film the show.
5. Basic sound equipment will be available for performers for the show. However, no special lighting or special effects (such as smoke machines, special scenery, etc.) may be used. Please list all technical needs on the application form provided.
6. Each solo/duet act is limited to 3 minutes of actual performance time. Each group act is limited to 5 minutes of actual performance time and 3 minutes of setup and breakdown time combined. If a performer uses more than 5 minutes in the performance time, a deduction of 1 point for every 30 seconds over will be assessed in the overall rating score.
7. All performances should be in good taste and school appropriate. Acts containing music, lyrics, gestures, costumes, or material that the judges consider to be rude or offensive may have points deducted or be disqualified.

8. Judges will base their evaluation in the following categories for both the audition and final show:
  - o Showmanship
  - o Creativity
  - o Content
  - o Quality of Act
9. The decisions of the judges are final.
10. Those acts selected for the final show will be judged on the same rating scale with the same criteria as the auditions.
11. The judges will be selected and will represent the members of the community, as well as CCMHS faculty and staff.
12. The judges will determine the winners in each category (Solo/Duet and Group) first, second and third place awards.
13. Applicants need to come on time to all talent show events.
  - a. Contestants auditioning live will need to be at the auditions (Fine Arts Suite Room 5-118) at **1:55 p.m. on February 16, 2018** in order to sign in and receive an explanation of rules and procedures. If a performer has a conflict, video submissions will be accepted up until **February 16, 2018**.
  - b. For contestants accepted into the talent show there will be a mandatory dress/tech rehearsal after school on a date to be determined prior to the talent show on **March 12, 2018. (MONDAY)**
  - c. For the final show on **March 14 and 15, 2018** contestants need to be in room 5-118 by **12:00 PM**. Any contestants arriving late without prior approval may be disqualified from performing. Students will receive an **SRA for period 5-6** (All performers will eat first lunch then report to Room 5-118 and are responsible for making up any missed work. You will receive a pass to be dismissed from lunch.
14. CCMHS has the sole authority to disqualify any contestant during any level of the contest for failure to comply with the rules and regulations stated above.
